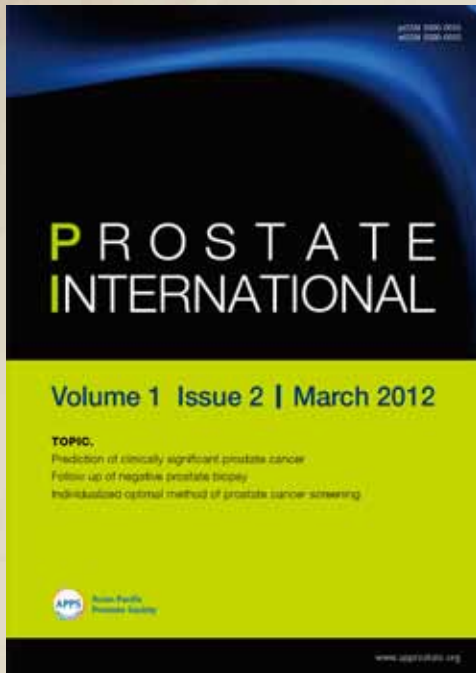

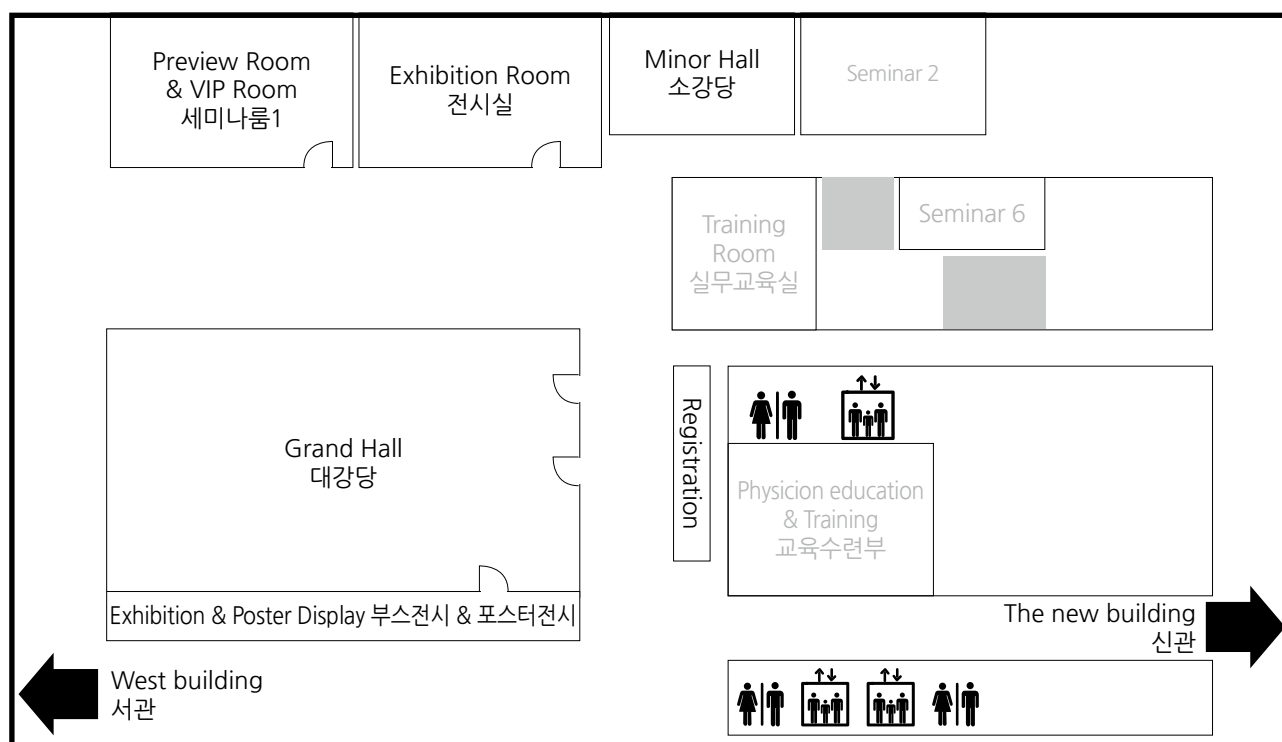

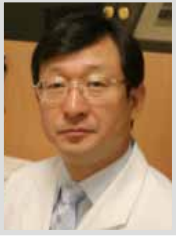

# INTRODUCTION OF APPS

I am delighted to have this opportunity to introduce the Asian Pacific Prostate Society (APPS) today. Hello, I am Ji Youl Lee, the Secretary General of APPS.
